### Controlled Assessment Tasks

	Task 1 (There will be only one task in Geography)
Details of Task	The task will take the form of an investigative study of the Colin River and will test several hypotheses. Initial planning will be followed by fieldwork in the third term of Y11. Thereafter a report will be written to include an introduction, presentation of results, analysis and interpretation of results and a conclusion and evaluation. The report will be produced under teacher supervision; appendices will be included with evidence of both the initial planning and fieldwork which preceded the writing of the report.
Word limit	2000 words
Amount of time for Task Taking (1 <sup>st</sup> Stage)	This involves planning (no specified time allocation), fieldwork (up to 6 hours) and the initial section of the report i.e. introduction and data presentation (up to 12 hours).
Period allocation for Task Taking (1 <sup>st</sup> Stage)	Planning will require several periods during normal timetabled classes; fieldwork will be a day out of school. This will take place in term 3 of Y11.

Amount of time for Task Taking (2 <sup>nd</sup> Stage)	This involves completing the report i.e. analysis, interpretation, conclusion and evaluation; this must be done within a 6 hour time frame.
Period allocation for Task Taking (2 <sup>nd</sup> Stage)	This may be done during September of Y12 during normal timetabled classes.
Venue	Geography classroom
Presentation e.g. handwritten using black ink	ICT will be used for data presentation. The first stage will be word processed; the second stage will be handwritten.
